UBC seeks outstanding graduate students to join a collaborative research project on Indigenous-led impact assessment. **The start date is September 2019.** This position is based in Interdisciplinary Graduate Studies (Sustainability) at The University of British Columbia's Okanagan campus in Kelowna, BC. The successful candidate will examine the implementation capacity, and regulatory needs for supporting Indigenous led impact assessment in Canada; with a focus on the British Columbia context. The research will examine case studies and process models. The research is applied. An understanding of and/or experience with the Canadian regulatory and legal setting is important. Experience working with Indigenous governments/organizations or communities is an asset. Students with degrees in Geography, planning, environmental sciences/studies, Indigenous studies, and related fields are encouraged to apply. The position is funded. Travel within Western Canada may be required. The position is funded. This student will join the Centre for Environmental Assessment Research with Dr. Kevin Hanna and Dr. Kerry Black.
